American Express Community Stadium Brighton and Hove Albion Football Club

Described as one of the most visually appealing sports stadiums in the UK, this state of the art community stadium, which seats 22,500, was a hugely challenging project for the CA Roofing Services team.

The £93 million structure was designed specifically to provide as much natural light as possible for the players. Translucent roof panels, installed in the area above the main stand, were colour matched to the client's exact requirements and these, combined with a reflective silver wall cladding, further enhanced the natural light, creating a unique finish.

Amazon Distribution Centre Dunfermline

Faced with strict time constraints on a project of more than 80,000m², detailed planning of Amazon's Scottish distribution centre was critical.

CA Roofing Services installed a Carbon Neutral® built-up roof and wall system incorporating non-flammable man-made mineral fibre insulation which delivered the low U-values demanded by the client.

Despite a two-week weather disruption, the building envelope was completed within the agreed 14 weeks. Lining of the building only took a further eight weeks bringing in the build well ahead of the programmed schedule.
